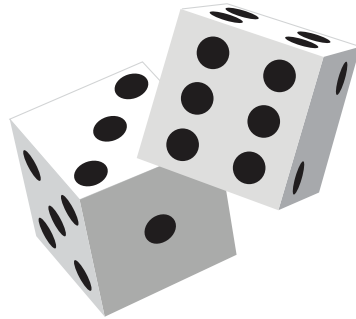

RECENT MAJOR GRANTS:

PRIMARY CENTERS

Children attending the newly opened Wilson and Jefferson primary centers have enjoyed the use of two new age appropriate and handicapped accessible playgrounds thanks in part to a \$75,000 grant from SEF.

SNAP – SUMMER NEEDS ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Through the support of an SEF grant, the school district held a four-week academic program at Jefferson School last summer to help ESL and at-risk low income students retain and/or boost necessary skills for the upcoming academic year.

INTERACTIVE LEARNING THROUGH THE USE OF SMART BOARDS

SEF purchased and installed five SMART boards as a pilot program at Lincoln-Hubbard School (four in the fourth grade classrooms and one in the Resource Room). Use of the SMART boards has enabled teachers to design technology-based lessons that address the individual needs of students.

HOMEWORK HELP: PEER (YEAR 2)

Homework Help has evolved into a peer tutoring program with the oversight of three teachers. Selected 8th grade students assist their peers in the middle school with homework in all subject areas, including organizational skills. Sessions are conducted twice a week after school and once a week before school.

MANDARIN CHINESE

SEF has provided funds to establish a long-sequence course of Mandarin Chinese. The district plans to roll out the program by 2010 and offer the course to all students in grades 6 – 12.

EXTENDING LITERACY THROUGH MATHEMATICS

SEF has purchased mathematics-focused books that will enhance and extend instruction in literacy to math in grades K through 5. The books demonstrate the power of math, while improving literacy skills.

MODERN OPTICAL EXPERIMENTATION AND DEMONSTRATION STATION

An "Optics Lab on Wheels" funded by SEF will be used in chemistry, physics and biology classes at the high school. The equipment allows for interdisciplinary demonstrations and labs and can enable students to complete high quality science fair projects in-house.

QUINTESSENCE AND INSIGHT/OUT

SEF provided the funds to reinstate the literary and art magazines at the high school which had been cut from the district's budget.

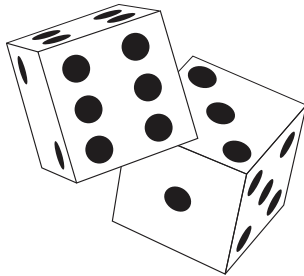

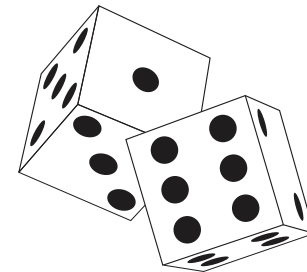
